This is to invite you to learn more about the Community Power opportunity for Harrisville, about which our Select Board wants you to be educated.

Due to state laws passed in 2019, municipalities in New Hampshire have the opportunity to combine all of their resident and business electric use into one larger electric load aggregation and get lower kilowatt per hour rates, plus other important services like more weatherization and renewable energy not currently available through Eversource (our default utility).

The Select Board has established an Electric Aggregation Committee (EAC) to research and share information on what Harrisville might do in regard to improving its electrical service possibilities.
