

## **NH ends COVID pandemic State of Emergency June 11 at midnight — after 15 months**

The Town's Emergency Management Director and Health Officer note that what this means for Harrisville and our municipal operations is that we may exercise choice and honesty in following the prevailing national guidelines, which the team strongly supports.

Those guidelines continue to advise wearing masks if you are not vaccinated and maintaining physical distancing at 6 feet.

Otherwise, it is your choice whether to wear a mask around and about Town unless otherwise posted by locations such as the Library, Post Office, and Town Hall.

Until further updates:

**Town Hall**, we ask that if you have not received the vaccine, wear a mask.

**Town Hall meeting room**, we will maintain a physical-distanced seating set up.

**Boards and Committees**, meetings will continue in hybrid format (in-person and Zoom channel). In-person quorum is required.

- **Library**, Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays 2 - 6pm, Wednesdays 9am - 1pm and 4 -7pm, and Saturdays 9am - 1pm (note in-person guidelines)
- **Tax Collector**, offering extended hours until July 2: Tuesdays from 1:30 - 6:30pm and Fridays from 9 am to 1pm (closed Tuesday June 15).
- **Town Clerk**, Tuesdays 11am - 4pm, Wednesdays 10am - 2pm, Thursdays 9am - 2pm, and first Saturday of each month, 8 - 11am
