And to further authorize the withdrawal of \$30,000 from the Roads Capital Reserve Fund for that purpose, the balance of \$57,500 \$62,500 to come from general taxation. This shall be a non-lapsing appropriation per RSA 32.7(VI) and will not lapse until completed or December 31, 2023 2024, whichever is sooner – Passed as Amended

Article 7: Town Hall Painting (exterior) - Passed

Article 8: Police Department Cruiser – Passed as Amended

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$61,153 to purchase and detail a new 2022 Police Cruiser for the purpose of equipping the Police Department with a second cruiser. And to authorize the withdrawal of \$36,000 from the Police Equipment Capital Reserve Fund for that purpose, the balance of \$25,153 to come from general taxation. [ADDED] This shall be a non-lapsing appropriation per RSA 32:7(VI) and shall not lapse until completed or December 31, 2023, whichever is sooner. - Passed as Amended.

Article 10: Silver Lake for Everybody Plan – Ballot vote – 82 Yes, 98 No, 1 Non-vote – Article Defeated
