

**NexTrex Recycle info – <https://recycle.trex.com/view/educate>
Volunteer-Run Program begun at Harrisville's Transfer Station 9/2/2022**

ACCEPTABLE: (Must be CLEAN, DRY and STRETCHABLE - Put these in the WHITE NexTrex Bins.)

General rule of thumb: When in doubt, throw it out.

- 1) Grocery Bags or retail store bags
- 2) Bread bags
- 3) Store dispensed Fruit/Veggie Produce bags (with no mesh or holes)
- 4) Paper towel/toilet paper overwrap
- 5) Plastic Bottle or other beverage container Case wrap
- 6) Pallet wrap
- 7) Dry cleaning bags
- 8) Newspaper sleeves
- 9) Ziploc and other resealable food storage bags
- 10) Bubble wrap or Air pillows
- 11) Plastic shipping envelopes – NO Need to remove label
- 12) Furniture and Electronic wrap
- 13) Ice bags
- 14) Wood pellet bags
- 15) Salt bags
- 16) Plastic Cereal box liners (That stretch; your finger will not pop through)
- 17) Any plastic bags/film labeled with a #2 (HDPE) or a #4 (LDPE)
- 18) If it is clean, dry + can stretch, it can be included (as long as it is NOT labeled a #5 or a #7)

NOT ACCEPTABLE: (DIRTY, WET or NOT STRETCHABLE - Put these in your trash.)

- 1) Frozen Food bags
- 2) Saran-type wrap
- 3) Zip-lock packaging for cheese (sliced/shredded)
- 4) Candy bar wrappers
- 5) Chip bags
- 6) Net or mesh produce bags
- 7) Mulch or soil bags
- 8) Pet food bags
- 9) Hot dog or meat wrap packaging
- 10) Six-pack rings
- 11) Pre-washed salad bags
- 12) PPE – gloves, masks, or protective wear
- 13) Pool covers
- 14) Lamination film
- 15) Silage or hay bags
- 16) Vinyl shower curtains or tablecloths
- 17) Bedding or linen packaging
- 18) Shiny, crinkly films like floral wrap
- 19) Anything with a real zipper
- 20) Any bag labeled degradable and/or compostable
- 21) If it cannot stretch or it tears like paper – it can't be included
- 22) If it is shiny, metallic, or makes a crinkly/crunchy sound – it can't be included
- 23) Any plastic bags/film labeled with a #5 or a #7
- 24) Any plastic bags/film with a slash through the recycle symbol
- 25) Any type of styrofoam
