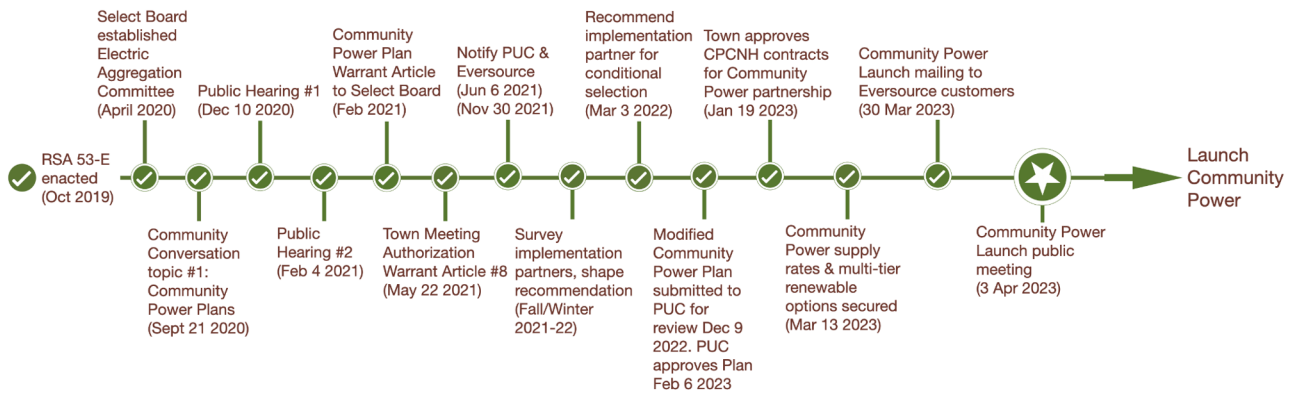

<p>Harrisville Community Power purchases electricity supply from sources that meet Town’s Community Plan criteria</p>	<p>Eversource delivers electricity using its power line infrastructure & billing mechanisms</p>	<p>Harrisville Energy Customers save money, access more affordable renewable supply, accumulate reserve funds</p>



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Highlights

- Most Eversource default electric supply customers automatically enrolled by end-May.
- Community Power listed as default electricity with new supply rate by June bill (charging for May use).
- Eversource delivers electricity.
- Participation is voluntary (with option to opt-out at any time).
- Third-party supply customers can choose to opt-in (*Check first if/what fees for early termination apply.*)
- Community Power is self funded = no tax appropriation.



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Community Benefit = Savings + Reserves

Short-term savings: ± \$15-26 / mo in May, June, July

Long-term benefits: Accrue reserve funds to apply to rate stability & local energy projects







 23.4%	Granite Basic <i>(Default Power Option)</i>	15.8¢	± \$95 / month
 33%	Granite Plus	16.2¢	± \$97 / month
 50%	Clean 50	16.9¢	± \$101 / month
 100%	Clean 100	19.1¢	± \$115 / month
 23.4%	Eversource	20.2¢	± \$121 / month

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Mid-sized Commercial Customers (auto-enrolled)

Community Power variable, Granite Basic (default) rate offers a 10% discount for Primary General Service customers (Class GV)

Mid-sized commercial customers can also opt-up for additional renewable mix 0.4¢ / kWh (Granite Plus), 1.1¢ / kWh (Clean 50) or 3.3¢ / kWh (Clean 100)

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Customers & Net Metering

Q: Net Energy Metering (NEM) customers **will NOT be automatically enrolled** and **do not need to opt-out** at this time. **Why?**

- Utilities have yet to put in place the required processes to track, bill, credit and provide data to HCP for NEM customers.
- CPCNH is engaged NH PUC to help resolve this issue and bring utilities into compliance.
- When resolved, HCP will offer Net Metering rates and terms to compensate or credit customers for the electricity supply component of surplus generation and encourage adoption of distributed generation and storage.

Net Metered customers who wish to explore opting-in at this juncture should call 1-866-603-POWR to discuss your options.



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Harrisville Town & Net Metering

Q: What about the Town of Harrisville accounts and our Net Metering?

- At launch, the Select Board will enroll municipal accounts in Community Power except the Town Hall/Fire Station meter that handles the existing solar array.
- By the time the new power generation system is installed, perhaps a year from now, we would hope that the PUC will have brought Eversource into compliance with the law.
- If so, then both new and old array accounts can be included in Community Power.



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Customers & Third Party Suppliers

Q: Third party supplier customers **will NOT be automatically enrolled. Why?**

- You have already made a choice regarding where your electricity is supplied from.
- Your contract with a third party may have a different rate than Eversource.
- Your contract with a third party may have early termination fees.

Third Party Supplier customers who wish to explore opting-in should call 1-866-603-POWR to discuss your options (and be aware of any fees for early term).



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Commercial Customers

Q: What about other types of customers? Is there anyone else that won't be automatically enrolled?

Remember that Mid-sized Commercial Customers are auto-enrolled.

The following other classes of customers **are NOT auto-enrolled.**

- Large General Service (Class LG)
- Backup Service (Class B)
- Commercial & Industrial electric vehicle charging station customers (Class EV-2)

Customers in these other classes who wish to explore opting-in should call 1-866-603-POWR to discuss your options.



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Missing Letters

Q: What if I didn't get a letter from Harrisville Community Power?

All customers have been mailed enrollment notification letters even those customers who are not eligible for automatic enrollment.

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Customers & Electric Assistance

Q: Does Harrisville Community Power have a provision for people to apply for electric assistance based on income, similar to what Eversource currently offers?

(or, can an Eversource default customer who receives electric assistance participate in CP at this juncture?)

Yes, at any plan level

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Future Options

Q: What should I know about processing changes to my opt-in/opt-out and service plan choices? Is there any restriction to frequency?

There is no transactional limitation, effective with next billing cycle depending on when change is requested and received.

ISO New England

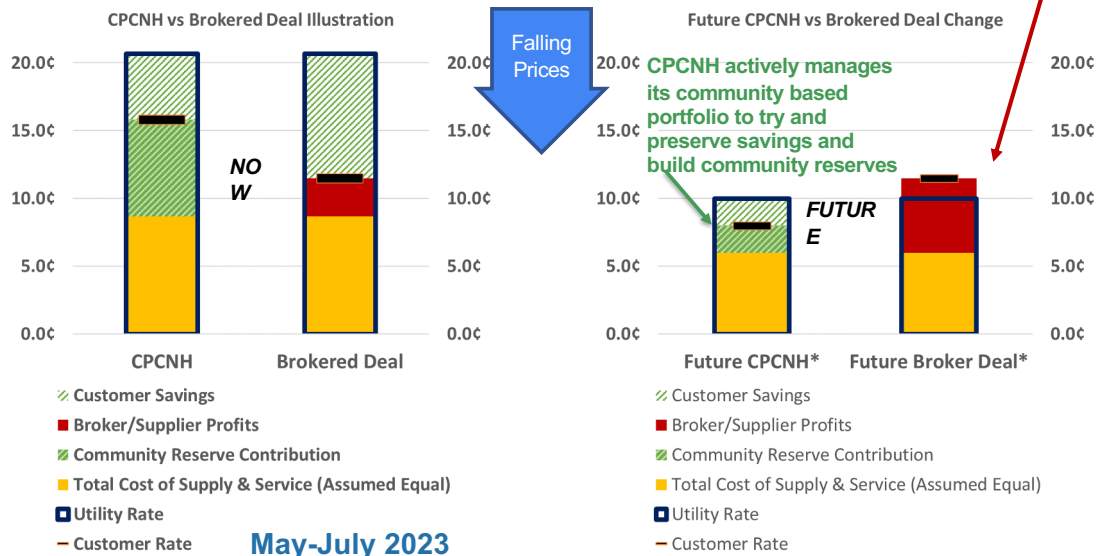
The CPCNH coalition supplies power through contracted vendors:

- First purchase provides supply for 10 launch communities through the end of July
- Purchase from ISO-NE system power (hedge, day-ahead, & real time markets)
- Source will change & evolve over time
- Supplier source disclosure for REC purchases will comply with NH's RPS and environmental disclosure requirements
- On the bill "Community Power" (dba trade name belonging to CPCNH)
