## **Voluntary Lot Merger: Overview**

In accordance with NH RSA 674:39-a, any owner of 2 or more contiguous preexisting approved or subdivided lots or parcels who wishes to merge them for municipal regulation and taxation purposes may do so by applying to the Planning Board.

Except as set forth in RSA 674:39-a II and III, all such requests shall be approved, and no public hearing or notice shall be required. No new survey plat need be recorded, but a notice of the merger, sufficient to identify the relevant parcels and endorsed in writing by the Planning Board, shall be filed for recording in the Registry of Deeds, and a copy received by the assessing officials.

No such merged parcel shall thereafter be separately transferred without subdivision approval. No city, town, county, or village district may merge preexisting subdivided lots or parcels except upon the consent of the owner.

**Note:** Mortgage holder consent is required per RSA 674:39-a II. Written consent of each mortgage holder shall be required as a condition of approval.

## **Voluntary Lot Merger: Process and Application Overview**

- 1. Complete the Application for a Voluntary Lot Merger and submit it to the Select Board Office to be processed. Please submit two (2) signed copies of the application.
  - The new parcel will be known as the parcel with existing buildings on it.
  - A recording fee will be required at the time of recording at the Cheshire County Registry of Deeds.
  - \*Please refer to fee schedule
  - ONE copy will be retained in the Assessor files, one (1) copy in the Cheshire County Registry of Deeds, and one (1) signed copy will be returned to the owner(s).
- 2. The Planning Board will consider the Application at the first regularly scheduled meeting following receipt of the Application and, if applicable, Mortgage Holder(s) Consent.
- 3. If the Planning Board determines that additional information is required, up to an additional ten (10) days will be afforded to produce the additional information.
- 4. If the Application is granted, the appropriate changes will be noted on the Tax Maps, Assessor records, and shall be recorded at the Cheshire County Registry of Deeds.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the Owner to record the approved application at the Cheshire County Registry of Deeds.
- 6. Application shall be provided in both hard copy and PDF formats.
